Neighborhood Registration Program

The goal of this program is to foster communication between neighborhoods and the City of Appleton. This program will assist in educating participants on the benefits of neighborhood organization as well as to provide support and communication to neighborhoods working to help themselves.

The foundation of the program is a neighborhood registry, which provides a direct link between your neighborhood and the City of Appleton. The registry is also useful to City staff, who may contact the neighborhood regarding issues of interest.



Benefits of Registering your Neighborhood

- Assistance in organizing your neighborhood and facilitating group meetings
- Map and demographic information of your neighborhood
- Connect your neighbors and local businesses in your neighborhood
- Receive press releases and information on city events, workshops and other valuable educational opportunities from the Community and Economic Development Department
- Information on forming Neighborhood Watch Groups
- Eligibility for participation in the Neighborhood Academy which is offered in collaboration with Sustainable Fox Valley*
- Notification from developers interested in obtaining neighborhood input on projects
- Eligibility for neighborhood grants*
- Presentation to registered neighborhoods by various City staff

Steps to Registering Your Neighborhood

- 1st** Meet with your neighbors to decide on a neighborhood name and define the neighborhood boundaries (*New neighborhood boundaries cannot overlap with existing registered neighborhood boundaries*).
- 2nd** Complete a neighborhood registration form available at the Community and Economic Development Dept. and online at www.appleton.org
- 3rd** Assign a neighborhood leader (primary contact) and a secondary contact that will represent your neighborhood.
