FOX CITIES ROOM TAX COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES

DATE: June 18, 2018

 - I. <u>CALL TO ORDER</u>: Mr. Sherman called the meeting to order at 3:00pm.
 - **II.** <u>**ROLL CALL of MEMBERSHIP**</u>: A list of Commission members was passed around and those in attendance initialed the sheet. A copy of the Fox Cities Area Room Tax Commission Bylaws was provided in the meeting packet as a reference for new appointees.
- III. <u>MINUTES:</u> Minutes of the April 9, 2018 meeting were mailed in advance. <u>Mr. Benz moved</u> approval of the December minutes as presented. Second by Ms. Johnson. Motion carried.
- IV. <u>FINANCIAL REPORT</u>: The City of Kaukauna's 4th quarter 2017 and 1st quarter 2018 room tax remains outstanding. William Van Rossum, Finance Director for the City of Kaukauna, was in attendance as the City has not yet appointed a member to the Commission. Mr. Van Rossum reported that he has been in contact with the hotel owner and City will move ahead with legal action to collect the outstanding tax.

Commission members were given a copy of the June 12, 2018 financial report and a 1st quarter 2018 summary of room tax collections. 1st quarter Expo Center room tax held by the CVB has been wired to Associated Trust.

V. <u>PRESENTATION ON FISCAL AGENCY AGREEMENT & REPORTING PROCESS</u>: Eric Wied of Associated Trust presented an overview of the new Fiscal Agency Agreement & Reporting process. Beginning with 2nd quarter 2018 room tax, hotel owners will submit the Hotel and Motel Transient Room Tax Quarterly Return form, along with the Fox Cities Room Tax Summary sheet. The CVB has held meetings to inform area hoteliers of the change to reporting requirements. It was suggested that the CVB provide a notice template to each of the municipalities so that they may send reminders to the hotel general managers as well.

- VI. <u>REPORT ON FINAL FINANCING DETAILS OF THE FOX CITIES EXHIBITION CENTER BONDS</u>: Brad Viegut of Baird provided a document which summarizes the Fox Cities Exhibition Center Hotel/Motel Room Tax Revenue Bonds Final Financing Plan.
- VII. <u>CVB REPORT</u>: Ms. Seidl commented on current occupancy rates and selling efforts being made by CVB staff in the convention and sports markets.
- VIII. OLD BUSINESS: None.

IX. <u>NEW BUSINESS:</u>

- **1.** Room Tax Commission Annual Report: The 2017 Annual Report of the Fox Cities Area Room Tax Commission was including in the meeting packet.
- 2. Consideration and Potential Action on Resolution regarding Grand Chute CDA 2018: Commission members were given a copy of the Resolution Authorizing the Execution and Delivery of Documents relating to the Fox Cities Sports Facility Project and asked to act of the Cooperation Agreement and the Pledge and Security Agreement. With the exception of the City of Appleton, all other municipalities have either adopted the agreement, or it is on their schedule for review and approval. Additional discussion surrounded the timeline for closing on the financing of the sports facility project and Section 3.03 of the agreement pertaining to the costs of construction. A document detailing the Estimated Project Budget's Source of Funds was passed out to members. <u>Mr. Easker moved</u> <u>approval of the Cooperation Agreement and the Pledge and Security Agreement.</u> <u>Second by Mr. Benz. Motion carried with Mr. Saucerman voting nay.</u>
- 3. Election of Officers for 2018-2019: <u>Ms. Harkness moved to keep the current slate of officers as is. Second by Mr. Saucerman. Motion carried.</u>
- 4. Appointment of Hoteliers for 2018-2019: <u>Mr. Sherman moved to accept Deb Johnson of the Copperleaf Hotel, and Chuck Gifford from the Comfort Suites as hotel representatives on the Fox Cities Room Tax Commission. Second by Ms. Harkness.</u> <u>Motion carried.</u>
- X. <u>ADJOURNMENT: Mr. Sherman moved for adjournment. Second by Mr. Wilde. Motion</u> <u>carried.</u>
