

Reporting an Illicit Discharge

An Illicit discharge is any discharge into a municipal storm sewer system that is not composed entirely of stormwater. Some of the pollutants that fall into this category are:

Gas and motor oil

Grass clippings

Cooking/deep frying oils

Household cleansers

Paints

Pesticides

Pet waste

Solvents

Weed killer

Carpet cleaning wash water

Pool and Hot Tub Water (must be dechlorinated and tested before discharge)

These materials can adversely affect our waterways, including fish, wildlife, and native plants. If you see or suspect that these materials have been spilled into the street gutter or into a street curb storm drain, please call the City Inspections Division at 920-832-6411 to report it. City staff will make a site inspection and determine the appropriate cleanup action.
