Bird Electric Scooters FAQs

CITY OF APPLETON - 2021

How old do I have to be to ride a scooter?

18 years or older

How much does it cost to ride a scooter?

\$1 plus 39 cents for every minute of use



How many scooters will be available in Appleton?

The pilot program will launch with 50 scooters throughout the City in high-foot-traffic areas and scale up to 100 depending on rider demand.

How do I rent a scooter?

- 1. Download the Bird app from the App Store or Google Play
- 2. Create an account and enter payment details
- 3. Use the map to find a scooter near you
- 4. Scan the QR code on the scooter with the app

How do I operate a scooter?

Hit the throttle on the right to go and pull the brakes to slow.

How fast does a Bird scooter go?

15 mph

Where can I ride an electric scooter?

Bird scooters must be ridden within the pilot area. See map here.

- Sidewalks OUTSIDE of College Avenue between Drew Street and Badger Avenue
- Right side of a roadway
- Bike lanes
- Trails

Where are scooters prohibited?

- Parking ramps
- College Avenue sidewalk between Drew Street and Badger Avenue

Where can I park a scooter?

Bird electric scooters are dockless, meaning you can leave them at your destination so long as you park them in an upright position; out of the way of pedestrian walkways, roadways, and driveways; and off private property.

How do I report reckless riding and improperly parked scooters?

For abandoned or improperly parked scooters not causing an immediate safety hazard, all complaints should be given to Bird at **(866) 205-2442**. You can also report "Badly Parked Bird" and "Damaged Bird" using the mobile app. You do not have to be a rider to use this feature of the app, however, you do need to create an account. For reckless riding (and improperly parked scooters causing a hazard), please call the Appleton Police non-emergency number **(920) 832-5500**.

How do I report a crash or injury involving a scooter?

Call 911. APD will respond to and process the crash/injury as they would any other crash. Crashes or injuries can also be reported to Bird through the app, via phone, or via email at **safetyteam@bird.co**.

Tips for Riding Safely

- Use caution in parking lots.
- Do not enter the road recklessly.
- Do not ride on the wrong side of the road.
- Use hand signals if riding in the road to signal turns and abrupt stops.

- Yield to pedestrians and keep walkways accessible.
- Even though it is not required, we highly recommend wearing a helmet.
