FOX CITIES ROOM TAX COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES

 - I. <u>CALL TO ORDER</u>: Mr. Easker called the meeting to order at 3:01pm.
 - **II.** <u>**ROLL CALL of MEMBERSHIP**</u>: Ms. Tisler conducted a roll call of those in attendance.
- III. <u>MINUTES:</u> Minutes of the March 2021 were included in the June meeting packet. <u>Mr. Benz</u> <u>moved approval of the March minutes as presented. Second by Mr. Wilde. Motion</u> <u>carried.</u>
- IV. <u>ELECTION OF OFFICERS</u>: Mr. March made a motion to re-elect Mr. Easker as Chair of the Fox Cities Room Tax Commission for the 2021 – 2022 year. Seconded by Mr. Benz. Mr. Easker accepted the position of Chair. Motion carried.

Mr. Easker made a motion to elect Mr. March as Vice Chair of the Fox Cites Room Tax Commission for the 2021 – 2022 year. Seconded by Mr. Gifford. Mr. March accepted the position of Vice Chair. Motion carried.

Mr. Easker made a motion to re-elect Mr. Dearborn as Secretary of the Fox Cities Room Tax Commission for the 2021 – 2022 year. Second by Mr. Benz. Mr. Dearborn accepted the position of Secretary. Motion carried.

<u>APPOINTMENT OF HOTELIERS:</u> <u>Given the Commission Chair's authority to appoint</u> hoteliers to the Commission, Mr. Easker re-appointed Ms. Johnson and Mr. Gifford as Fox Cities Room Tax Commission hotel representatives for the 2021 – 2022 year. Ms. Johnson and Mr. Gifford accepted. V. <u>FINANCIAL REPORT</u>: Ms. Seidl provided an overview of the May 2021 financial report, and gave an update on the status of 1st quarter 2021 room tax collections. A summary of 2016-2021 collections was included in the June meeting packet.

1st quarter 2021 room tax is outstanding from one City of Kaukauna lodging property.

Mr. Benz moved approval of the February financial report as presented. Second by Ms. Johnson. Motion carried.

- VI. <u>ROOM TAX BONDED PROJECTS</u>: Mr. Mehan provided a status update on room tax bonded projects, and the track of current room tax revenues to cover bond payments. Current projections indicate that there are sufficient funds available to cover bond payments through February 2022. He does not anticipate needing to access reserves in order to cover future payments.
- VII. <u>CVB REPORT</u>: Ms. Seidl reported that sports and leisure markets continue to lead the post-Covid recovery, but business travel is beginning to pick up. 2022 is seeing a strong comeback for bookings at the Fox Cities Exhibition Center. Several large sporting events are expected to boost occupancy in the 4th quarter of 2021.

VIII. UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

- a. A Draft Letter of Invitation was presented for review and Commission member input. <u>Mr. Benz moved to approve the Draft as presented. Second by Ms. Johnson.</u> <u>Motion carried</u>.
- b. Ms. Seidl provided the historical background as to why smaller communities are not part of the Tourism Zone, and gave an overview as to what would need to happen in order for a community to join. Currently, nine area communities are not part of the Tourism Zone. It was agreed that a letter should go out to any community not currently party to the bonds, but who have enacted a room tax ordinance.
- IX. <u>NEW BUSINESS</u>: No new business to report.

X. <u>ADJOURNMENT: Mr. Wilde moved for adjournment. Second by Ms. Johnson. Motion</u> <u>carried.</u>

<u>Next meeting date:</u> Monday, September 20, 2021 at 3 p.m. Ms. Seidl will confirm the location yet to be determined, and offer a hybrid option for attendance.
