

Sensory Friendly Routine Vaccine Clinics

The clinics are designed for children with Autism, ADHD, other developmental disabilities, or anyone else who would benefit from a modified vaccination experience. Routine vaccinations will be offered, in addition to flu and COVID-19 vaccines and boosters if available.

Prior to the clinic, a social narrative will be available to help prepare participants for the vaccination experience. During the clinic, participants can expect individualized support throughout their appointment, sensory fidgets, distraction strategies, and other individualized accommodations as needed.

After appointments, participants can play in the museum until it closes at 7:00 pm.
