








Reactions from Residents

A few concerns related to merges and transitions.












- Parking meter users very much appreciate the buffer zone of the bike lane between the parking lane and traffic lane as it has provided another layer of safety when visiting downtown businesses.

- Police Department staff state that conducting traffic stops has become easier and safer.


